Family Violence Policy Office (FVPO) Web-Based Commander's Training, DoD

The Challenge

Prior to the dissolution of the Defense Task Force on Domestic Violence (DTFDV) in 2003, the Family Violence Policy Office (FVPO) was established to implement DTFDV recommendations within the Department of Defense (DoD). Many of the DTFDV recommendations pertain to training military personnel on the policies and procedures for dealing with domestic violence cases. Given the large number of military personnel requiring this training, FVPO required an online training tool to provide domestic violence training that would augment face-to-face training.

Our Strategy

Keymind built an interactive, Web-based training system to provide domestic violence training to commanders. Using video and multimedia elements, the team created a learning management system and a streamlined training course. The online training allows users to navigate through lessons of varying depth, optionally review a case study, and print out a certificate of completion. The training system allows FVPO staff to view reports on the usage of the site and perform administrative tasks and user management. The training system is both Sharable Content Object Reference Model

(SCORM) and Section 508 compliant. It was built using Oracle 10g, Microsoft .NET, and Adobe Flash.

The Impact

Keymind delivered a polished and user-oriented training tool that provides commander-level training online. The FVPO Web-Based Commanders' Training increases the reach of the FVPO office to installations worldwide and serves as a resource for military domestic violence policy.
